Invitation to register as an Interested and Affected Party (I&AP) and comment on the Environmental Impact Assessment Process for the Proposed Cairnbrogie Resort Camp, Kranshoek, Plettenberg Bay

Further notice is hereby given of a Public Participation Process in terms of Section 24 (5) of the National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, 107 of 1998) and Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014 (as amended) in respect of activities identified in terms of Regulation No. 324, No. 325 and No. 327 of the Act.

An application for Environmental Authorisation (EA) has been submitted at the Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning (DEA&DP). This application is subject to a basic assessment and a public participation process in terms of Regulation 41 of the EIA Regulations, 2014.

Background on activity: The proposal is for the creation of two resort nodes on the existing Cairnbrogie farm which are to provide accommodation for more than 15 people. Limited vegetation may need to be cleared during the establishment of the nodes.
